At the beginning of 2025, Antibiotice launched the project "Education in Action: Enhancing Accessibility and Relevance of Vocational and Technical Education through Practical Training at Antibiotice S.A.", aimed at students in pre-university vocational and technical education. The project is co-financed by the European Social Fund through the Education and Employment Program 2021-2027 and will be carried out over a period of 36 months.

The selected students will participate in training sessions held at the Antibiotice headquarters in Iași, conducted by company specialists, experts in the pharmaceutical field, with in-depth knowledge of international production and quality requirements. These internships will allow students to acquire key competencies, technical knowledge, and practical skills within a top pharmaceutical company, helping them develop essential abilities for their professional success.

The young trainees will qualify in professions such as laboratory chemical technician, operator in the pharmaceutical and cosmetics industry, electromechanic, mechanical technician for maintenance and repair, mechatronics technician, low-voltage electrician, and automation technician. At the end of the three-year project, graduates will have the opportunity to become employed at Antibiotice in various technical fields.
