Antibiotice Iași, ranked 1st among the most competitive companies in Romania for over 20 years

Antibiotice Iași has won the National Award - 1st place at the 31st edition of the National Top of Companies Gala, organized by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Romania. The award was given in the category Industry - Large Enterprises - Manufacture of Basic Pharmaceutical Products.

For over 30 years, the National Top of Companies has been a true barometer of business performance, ranking the most competitive firms in Romania, reflecting the value and dynamics of the business environment. Antibiotice Iaşi has ranked 1st in this top for over 20 consecutive years in its field, for excellence in business both locally and nationally.

Performance and results recorded by Antibiotice lasi in 2023/2022:

- +28% increase in net turnover in the domestic market;
- 81.1 million lei net profit;
- +18% increase in net turnover from exports;
- 146% increase in the value of shares:
- 98 million lei investments to strengthen the business and develop the company's strategy;





- Obtaining a 25 million euro loan from the European Investment Bank, through the InvestEU facility, to support the company's investment program;
- 85 million lei non-reimbursable funds attracted through state aid for the production capacity of sterile products, solutions, and topicals;
- 4.1 million lei co-financing for a green energy production capacity.

This ranking, conducted by the System of Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Romania, includes data from over 800,000 financial statements of active companies in Romania that ranked in the top 10 positions in each analyzed field. Economic indicators used in the ranking include net turnover, operating profit, operating profit margin, efficiency in using human resources, and efficiency in using invested capital.
